Dear Friends,

The nominating Committee of Presbytery is **trying to locate and recruit members of as many congregations as possible who would be willing, if asked, to serve on an appropriate committee of the Presbytery.** I am writing you through the Presbytery's Website to ask you to prayerfully consider serving Jesus Christ as a member of a committee of your Presbytery.

With this letter is a two page information form that gives you a chance to list your experience and skills and interests so that we might know where you could make a positive contribution to the work of a committee that needs a person who matches your particular qualifications and interests. Your name would then be placed in the pool of available persons for the Nominations Committee of the Presbytery to consider when there is a vacancy on a committee.

Because the Presbytery is trying to put together committees that represent the whole Presbytery, there is also a section for you to give us basic information about the region in which your church is located, gender, race, lay or clergy, etc., so that we don't end up with a committee that is made up of all men or all women, or one where the majority of the members are from the same region of the Presbytery.

It helps the committee to **receive these completed forms by June 1st if possible but we accept them year round.** The Nominations Committee begins a real push for volunteers in late summer, with new committee members being nominated to the December meeting of the Presbytery. Newly elected folks begin service in January.

Filling out this form does not commit you to serve on a particular committee but makes you available to be considered and asked to serve.

Thank you for taking time to think about this opportunity for service. We hope that you will fill out the information form and return it to us.
